The term Science 2.0 stands for entirely new forms of research and publication processes, research collaborations, widened participation and the interaction of science with society. New information technologies gradually alter how we communicate, do research, collaborate and publish.

Critical voices argue that traditional assessment systems for scientific excellence lag behind these developments and demand that they should open up to Science 2.0's potentials and dynamics.

The Quadriga debate focuses on this tension between new opportunities and traditional standards. Arguing from different perspectives, the panelists discuss the transformation of science through digitization.

Due to the international composition of the panel, the debate will be in English.


